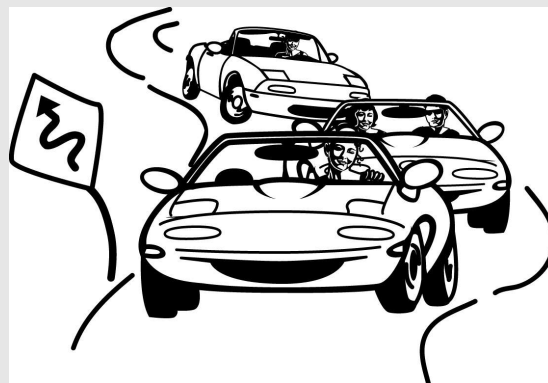
Earlybird Registration by Nancy Galvin

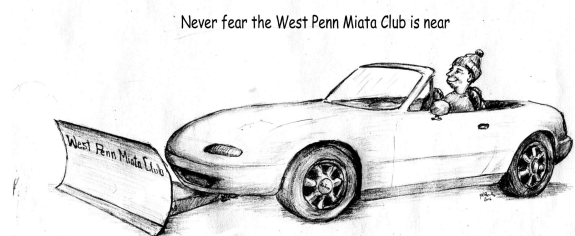

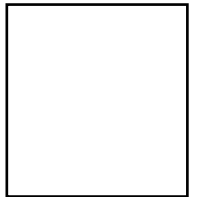
