Budd Baer Tech Session Report by George Kniss

he weather turned out to be perfect for our first day out and Tech Session at Budd Baer Mazda in Washington PA. About 14 members and guests attended and we were greeted by Mazda Sales Manager Jennifer Parish who, after lining up all of our tops-down Miatas in front of the dealership, convened us to the Conference Room and morning coffee. Linda Zimliki, our Events Chair, opened the meeting promptly with the announcement of our first cruise "Back In Time" on May 7th.....to 'Cars & Coffee' and Shakespeare's Castle. She went on to introduce Mazda Technician Lorenzo who immediately took a volley of questions from members running from tire tread depths & pressures to engine lights, to brake fluid levels, safety belt hang ups and timing chain concerns. Reserved for last was my subject, which I had prepared the group and Lorenzo on and that was my discovery, when I purchased my slightly used 2010 Miata PRHT (power retractable hard top) in December, of what to do if your powered hard top gets stuck in midcourse of going up or down.

I discovered that in the glove box was a small plastic bag with two steel rods, two loops of white plastic cord and a small printed note describing what this "tool kit" was. I learned through the Installation Manual, an 8 page detailed description of how to use the tool kit to secure the top if it hangs up. I read the guide over and over again, looked at the illustrations and the tool kit but could not understand the process completely.....I had questions! So, this was a perfect fit for a tech session examination. I discussed this with Lorenzo and he was willing, as was I, to use my car and tool kit to go through the procedure. The group then convened outside and Lorenzo proceeded. Many members were interested because we have more that a half dozen PRHT's in the club and apparently no one knows how to do this procedure in an emergency.

I raised the top mid way and Lorenzo proceeded, after some struggle with a screw that needs backing off 4 turns with the Allen Wrench rod tool in the kit, and not having a wrench socket to do otherwise, Lorenzo followed ahead in reading the rest of the procedure. We both read it over and over again many times and resolved that it was cryptic at best! It sort of reminded me of the old days when Japanese car instruction manuals were very poorly translated from Japanese to English. We did ultimately understand that one had to disengage the elevation gear on both sides of the rear of the top, place the looped rods and the white cords, then raise the top, then lower the cover with the cords and then tie them to the safety belt harness so that it doesn't open while driving.

As such, Lorenzo could not do the procedure, but promised that he would take this problem to the Mazda Technical Manager for resolution. He, though a bit embarrassed, promised that they would resolve this issue and post a video for us. He noted that the dealership had never encountered this problem before, not with the 2009 - 2015 PRHT nor the 2015 - 2022 'Fast Back' PRHT's. We all agreed that we would not be happy getting stuck with a stuck hard top out driving somewhere.

Lunch followed at the Union Grill in Washington PA with good food and conversation.

NOTE: The newer PRHT's (2015 - 2022 'Fast Back') apparently have the same tool kit, but also a pressurized container? TBD. We will inform all members of information we get back from Budd Baer on this.


