# CHRISTMAS OUTING PHIPPS WINTER FLOWER SHOW AND HOLIDAY MAGIC: Let It GLOW WINTER LIGHT GARDEN

his year is Phipps' 125th Anniversary and they have pulled all stops out for their famous Winter Garden and Light Show. There will be 2000 poinsettias, a

serpentine room of nutcrackers, toboggans and tea sets, plus a palm court, complete with historic ogee crest and color changing architectural lighting. A display of holiday trees made of tropical plants, succulents, sedums and goose feathers leads you to a 22 foot fraser fir over the Victoria Room's reflecting pond. A tree rotates atop an oversized music box. The grand finale takes you on a supersized journey beneath a decorated Christmas tree with Victorian inspired gifts with a tree skirt of poinsettias.

You will also see the Garden Railroad: Memories in Motion. It takes you on a locomotive journey through years at Phipps with interactive features. The Tropical Forest Cuba exhibit will have 250 feet of lights.

The Holiday Magic: Let It Glow Winter Light show is outside. It starts at 5:00 pm. It has to be dark for the light show so it will be a later outing. The light garden has ten six foot tall winter ice towers designed to resemble frosted windowpanes. We will do the Winter flowers first then Holiday Magic. For the Holiday Magic, you can purchase Holiday Hologram Glasses that use the amazing science of holographic diffraction to reveal festive snowflakes while looking at Phipps' sparkling spectacular LED displays. If you want a pair, let me know when you confirm. The cost is \$6 per pair. I will order when I get the tickets. Included with the glasses is a coupon for free popcorn or a pretzel at Cafe Phipps Holiday Hut.


